For five nights in July the halls of OBC rang with the joyful exuberance of children who had come for VBS. Thanks to regular tithes and offerings, designated offerings, and some workers who bought materials out of their own pocket, not to mention the time and talents of the 58 adult and 40 youth volunteer workers, we were able to provide a memorable experience for our own kids, kids who attend other churches regularly, and kids who rarely, if ever, go to church. One hundred children participated in a *High Seas Expedition-Exploring the Mighty Love of God*. Not only did the kids learn about God's love for them, but also how to show love to others. Because you give, we were able to provide free T-shirts to about 80 kids who registered for VBS by June 20, materials for crafts, CDs for music, props and decorations to make the place look like a ship, materials to make 12 fleece blankets to send to *Operation Kid to Kid* who will send the blankets on to children in Uganda, and all the supplies needed for VBS. In one short week we were able to make a lasting impression of God's love on a lot of kids and workers too. If you get a chance, ask any of the kids about VBS. You will delight in the responses you get.
