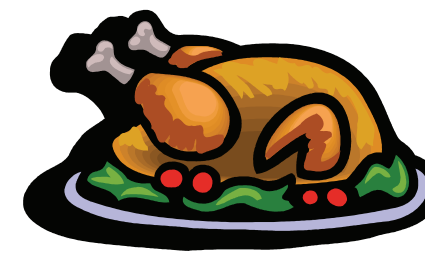
CONCERT BY THE MILLERS
