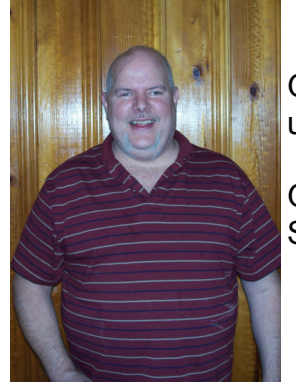

HAPPY AGERS, HAPPY AGERS

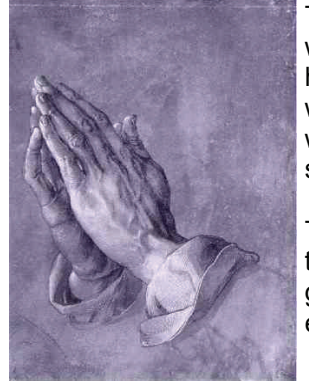

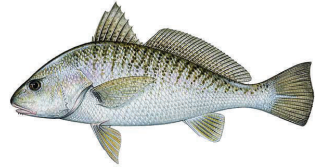
